

SPELLBOUND DRAMA COSTUME ASSIGNMENT

TOYMAKER

Check out www.briomissions.com for a picture of what this costume should look like

1. Three large white 100% cotton T-shirts (no writing).
2. One pair blue striped or solid denim overalls to fit you.

Please read all the information below carefully.

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Costuming Tips

1. You will most likely wear the costume you bring – make sure it fits you.
2. Bring your own pair of comfortable tennis shoes to wear while performing the drama. NO HIGH TOPS - they are awkward for performance, hot and heavy.

Make up essentials for all parts (guys don’t need to bring this):

EVIL MAGICIAN

Think dark.

1. One pair black sweats or knit pants with elastic waistband size medium or large.
2. One white cotton Oxford dress shirt. Size medium or large.
3. One black magic top hat (order from a magic shop online).
4. One men's Black suit vest, size medium. Check Good Will.
5. A lightweight black cape (cotton is best). It should be near knee length – THIS PIECE IS CRUCIAL!
6. Prop: Magic wand. You can make it out of a dowel rod spray painted black or buy one.

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KAT

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Make sure when the reference is to “bright” colors that you don’t purchase anything too bright. The audience needs to be able to look at you.

1. 2 or 3 solid bright colored T-shirts (no writing). Neon is perfect. (bring 1 small, 1 medium and 1 large)
2. “Cool” inexpensive sunglasses.
3. Bright socks - neon to match the T-shirts.
4. 2 bandannas that coordinate with the T-shirt.
5. Kats will wear their own jeans, jean shorts (modest length) or capris, you do not need to bring a pair for the costume. -Take note to bring your own though, in the event that you do get cast as a Kat.

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MIME

Your costume should be *lightweight* material.

1. One pair lightweight black knit or cotton elastic waist pants (size medium). These can be purchased at K-Mart, Walmart, or Target.
2. Two black short-sleeved T-shirts.(no writing, one size medium and one size large)

NURSE

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This character demands tidiness. Be a red and white candy-striper.

1. One white short sleeve blouse size small or medium – not low-necked. Securely sew a large red cross onto the front (it should be able to be seen from a distance). It is symbolic of your profession.
2. One pair lightweight red knit pants or capris with elastic waist. (size medium or large).
3. Prop: Toy stethoscope, as true to life size as possible.

PHOTOGRAPHER

Think tourist.

1. One Indiana Jones type hat. Remember to think low cost. Don't get an expensive one.
2. One short-sleeved tropical shirt.(size medium or large)
3. One pair of suspenders.
4. One pair of cotton dress (Docker's type) pants- can be dark or khaki (size medium or large) Try a thrift store for these.
5. Prop: a cheap (can be non-working) camera.

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PRINCE

Go for the preppy look - suave and debonair.

1. One pair Royal blue or dark lightweight pants (size medium or large)
2. Pastel (yellow, light blue, or white), Oxford-style, dress shirt (size medium or large)
3. Royal sash. Can be made out of satin or other material that looks regal. It will simply be draped over one shoulder and connected at the opposite hip.
4. A gaudy, rhinestone vintage brooch to secure your "royal sash."
5. Props: Plastic sword, approximately 2 feet in length AND an empty whiskey-looking bottle (a larger Listerine bottle would be perfect).

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PRINCESS

This character is the prissy, elegant counterpart to the prince.

1. One fluffy, pastel calf-length or long formal dress (not white) size 6-8. No low necklines. Cotton blend of fabrics would be the most comfortable in the hot climate. Provide an undershirt or slip if the dress is sheer. Check out Good Will sores for old prom dresses.
2. Royal sash. Can be made out of satin or other material that looks regal. It will simply be draped over one shoulder and connected at the opposite hip.
3. Gaudy rhinestone brooch for securing your "royal sash."
4. Rhinestone/sequin tiara (remember to think cheap, \$3-5). Can be purchased through Oriental Trading Company, Inc 1-800-228-2269- ask for a catalog
5. Prop: Large plastic handheld mirror.

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4. Knee-pads.

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SOLDIER (Think G.I. Joe)

1. One pair camouflage pants (size medium or large). Go to your local army surplus store.
2. One black, khaki or green t-shirt. (can be camouflage) No tank tops or shirts with the sleeves cut off.
3. One headband, a 3-inch strip of camouflage fabric to tie around the head OR 1 camouflage bandana.
4. Prop: Plastic M16 toy machine gun. (Pack it in your checked luggage. It will be fine going through airport security).

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SPANISH DANCER

Think back to old 'Zorro' films and Spanish flamenco dances. Stick with red, black and white.

1. Full red or black skirt, mid-calf in length; and elasticized waistband is best (size small or medium). Must be full enough for ballet movements.
2. White peasant style blouse (no off the shoulder, or low cut necklines). Please provide an undershirt if it is sheer.
3. Fringed black or red shawl .
4. Prop: 2 artificial roses (the bigger, the better!).

Note: if you cannot find a red skirt, substitute with a black, but use a red shawl to keep the color scheme complete.

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TOYMAKER'S SON

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1. Three large white 100% cotton T-shirt (no writing).
2. One pair blue striped or solid denim overalls, size 34 or 36 (Sears or Walmart).
3. Prop: a good set of kneepads.

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BASEBALL PLAYER

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Color-coordinate the following items:

1. Two pair of tube socks (white with color stripes).
2. One baseball jersey or t-shirt with a number on the back size medium or large.
3. One pair size medium or large (adult) baseball pants.
4. Prop: 1 large plastic baseball bat. Baseball cap optional.

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CHINA DOLL

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The China Doll is one of the toys - must be oriental looking.

1. One jacket-length kimono/Chinese jacket with a silky exotic look. Try a thrift store. Can be a bathrobe if it looks authentic (not terry-cloth). Applique's (dragons, exotic flowers etc.) can be applied to a satin robe to make it look oriental.
2. One pair lightweight, loose-fitting black pants or capris with elastic waist, size small or medium. No bell-bottoms or flare legs. Satin would be great.
3. Two accordion-fold paper fans that look oriental. Can be found ordered from Oriental Trading Company, Inc. 1-800-228-2269. Ask for a catalog.

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
